Dear Applicant:

To apply for a clearance, complete **one (1)** DEP Form 62-555.900(9) by typing or using ink for each permitted project: <u>http://dep.state.fl.us/water/drinkingwater/forms/62-555.900_9.pdf</u>

Clarify if the clearance is for a portion of the project or the entire project in Section I.C.

Complete Section II if there were any deviations from the permit scope or state if there were no deviations.

Signatures in Section III need to be dated.

The Professional Engineer (P.E.) needs to stamp, sign, and date in Sections II and III.D.

Submit at least **one (1)** copy of the following supporting documentation:

- DEP Form 62-555.900(9) (submit at least one (1) original);
- As-built drawings stamped by the P.E. or a Professional Surveyor (P.S.) registered in the State of Florida;
- Bacteriological sampling reports for each sample point depicted in the construction drawings. See sampling and disinfection requirements in 62-555.315(6) and 62-555.340 F.A.C.;
- Pressure Test Report per AWWA C600-05 or latest revision;
- Water and Sewer Main Separation per 62-555.314;
- A check for the fee corresponding to the linear feet of the water main per the Fees Memo (<u>http://broward.floridahealth.gov/programs-and-services/environmental-health/drinking-water/_documents/ee-fees-authorization-012016.pdf</u>);

Typical review time for clearances is 14 days. However, expedited review fees are provided below:

- One (1) business day = \$1,000
- Two (2) business days = \$750
- Three (3) business days = \$500

Note: Expedited fees included herein are specifically related to the turnaround time in which the department reviews the clearance packages. Payment of this fee does not guarantee the approval of a clearance or permit. It only guarantees that you will receive a review within the timeframe that is paid for. Each fee paid covers <u>one review</u> and not the entire review process or any resubmittals to requests for information.

DO NOT PLACE ANY NEW OR ALTERED PWS COMPONENTS INTO PERMANENT OPERATION UNTIL THE DEPARTMENT ISSUES WRITTEN APPROVAL, OR CLEARANCE, TO PLACE THE COMPONENTS INTO PERMANENT OPERATION.
