HIV/AIDS 500 and 501 TRAINING ON-LINE Instructions

- The Bureau of Communicable Diseases, HIV/AIDS Section release the **HIV/AIDS 500 training on-line** in the Florida Department of Health Official Learning Management System - TRAIN Florida-.
- The HIV/AIDS 500 is the prerequisite to the HIV/AIDS 501 classroom training that is required prior to offering publicly funded HIV testing services in Florida.
- The on-line training meets the requirements of *Technical Assistance Guideline 345-17-13, Minimum Standards for HIV Counselors, Trainers and Early Intervention Consultants*.
- The training is available to Department staff as well as community partners and serves as an alternative to the classroom training.

- The **FDOH HIV/AIDS 500 The Basics of HIV/AIDS Counseling, Testing and Linkage** course is a blended learning series of 7 sections including a learner's guide and an Introduction. Sections 1 through 5 are followed by a **short quiz**. Participants must complete each quiz in order, and with a **minimum score of 80%** before completing the course. Each section is also followed by an evaluation, which we ask participants to complete. Upon completion of the entire blended learning series, participants are issued a certificate for the course. The participant will then need to complete the FDOH HIV/AIDS 501 Online course.
- The **FDOH HIV/AIDS 501 HIV Prevention Counseling, Testing and Linkage-Introduction** course is a blended learning series of 8 sections including a learner's guide and an Introduction. Sections 1 through 6 are followed by a **short quiz**. Participants must complete each quiz in order, and with a **minimum score of 80%** before completing the course. Each section is also followed by an evaluation, which we ask participants to complete. Upon completion of the entire blended learning series, participants are issued a certificate for the course.
- **The certificate of completion for the HIV/AIDS 500 and 501 Online courses are required for the completion of registration and entry into HIV/AIDS 500/501 classroom training.**
